**New Rules: HOA will be Trap, Skeet, & Whiz Bang & Sporting Clays**

**There is no late registration.** Your 4-H Shooting Sports members are cordially invited to the 2015 South Plains District 2 Trap and Skeet Shoot. This activity will be held on June 26-27, 2015. Our aim is to offer you and your shooters a quality shoot with an exceptional awards program. This shoot could serve as a good warm-up just prior to State and assist in preparing your shooters for really stiff competition in the near future. Opening ceremonies will be conducted by Shooting Sports Ambassadors. **Please make payment for the group with one check to South Plains 4-H Shooting Sports.**

Please note the following:

- High Shooter District 2 in Trap & Skeet in Sr. 2 (that is a graduating senior) will receive a scholarship
- **2015 Registration fee for Trap, Skeet, Whiz Bang and Sporting Clays is \$25 per event. Round fees are \$9 a round for Trap and \$9 for Skeet. Round fee for Whiz Bang is \$25 for a round of 50 targets. Round fees are \$25 a round of 50 for Sporting Clays. Bring money to the shoot.**
- **Management reserves the right to change squads as needed.**

- Trap & Skeet number of targets: Jr. 50 Int. 75 Sr. 1 & Sr. 2 100. All age groups will shoot 50 targets for Whiz Bang & Sporting Clays.
- **Deadline for pre-registration: must be faxed no later than 5:00 p.m. June 22, 2015.**
- **At least three experienced volunteers per county to pull & score.**
- Eye and ear protection required.
- Management reserves the right to move shooters to open fields as needed.
- Trap on Friday, June 26; Skeet and Whiz Bang on Saturday, June 27.
- Counties will be squadded in order in which registration forms are received.
- No protest will be acknowledged without a \$100 protest fee and no discussions about a protest will be held on the range in front of the public. **Period. No Discussion.**
- We will Lewis class Jr. & Intermediate and have 3 classes in Trap, A, B, & C and place them 3 deep & in Skeet will have classes A & B & Place them 3 deep. Seniors will not be Lewis classed. No Lewis class on Whiz Bang or Sporting Clays.
- Class A will have Shootoffs in case of a tie, but B C ties will be broken on straights.
- There will be no ammunition for sale at the sites.
- Bring your own shade.
- Concession Stand will be available at both locations.
- We will follow rules on 4-H Shooting Sports, Sleeved Shirts, Closed toe shoes, No open toe shoes.
- **Mandatory orientation at 8:30 a.m.**

Registration will be from 8:00-8:30 a.m. Orientation will begin at 8:30 a.m. and competition will begin at 9 a.m. each day. Please plan to arrive early.

Trap will be held at the Palmer Gun Club in Garza County, located 10 miles west of Post on Hwy 380 (&- or) 16 miles east of Tahoka on North side of the road.

Skeet and Sporting Clays will be held at the Gaines County Shooting Range, 7 miles North of Seminole or 8 miles South of Seagraves on Hwy 62/385; then 1 mile West on CR 216, then .6 miles Northwest on CR 216A.
