The top three senior teams and/or individuals in the district contest will advance as representative of the district at Texas 4-H Roundup.

- ₩ Juniors will judge six placing classes only.
- ★ Intermediates will judge six placing classes, 30 retail ID, answer questions on 2 classes and give reasons over 1 class.
- ★ Seniors will judge six placing classes, 30 retail ID, and give reasons over 3 classes.

This contest will be using scantron forms for intermediates and seniors, juniors will be using placing cards. These will be provided to all participants on the day of the contest. Contestants need to bring a #2 pencil and a clipboard. Contests follow the Texas 4-H Roundup Contest Guidelines.

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\*Medical release, waiver, indemnification and code of conduct forms must be completed on 4-H Connect. If forms are not completed on 4-H Connect the 4-H member is responsible to bring a completed copy of all forms to registration to be eligible to participate in the contest.

It is the responsibility of the agents to validate birthdates of participants and correct placement of youth in age categories. It is also the responsibility of the agents to certify eligibility of contestants and substitutes.
