- The District 2 4-H Horse Quiz Bowl Contest will be divided up into Junior, Intermediate and Senior.
- Counties may enter as many Junior, Intermediate and Senior teams as needed. The top three senior teams in the district contest will advance as the representative of the district at Texas 4-H Roundup.
- This contest will be a double elimination event conducted with the same rules and guidelines as the State 4-H Horse Quiz Bowl Contest.

It is the responsibility of the agents to validate birth dates of participants and correct placement of youth in age categories. It is also the responsibility of the agents to certify eligibility of contestants and substitutes.

AGE REQUIREMENTS - Based on 2018-2019 4-H year age requirements effective as of 09/01/18.

- **Junior** – Grades 3, 4 & 5
- **Intermediate** – Grades 6, 7 & 8
- **Senior** – Grades 9, 10, 11 & 12
