AGE REQUIREMENTS - Age is based on 2018-2019 4-H year age requirements effective as of 09/01/18.

- **Junior** - Grades 3, 4 & 5 (and minimum age of 8)
- **Intermediate** - Grades 6, 7, & 8
- **Senior** - Grades 9, 10, 11, & 1
