



# 2019 North Region Shooting Sports Coach/Leader Training

**Disciplines: Archery, Pistol, Rifle and Shotgun**

<b>Dates:</b>	<b>April 6-7, 2019</b> , the training will begin at 8 a.m. on Saturday and continue into that evening. Training will continue on Sunday and end around noon.
<b>Location:</b>	Lubbock District Office - 1102 E Drew St (FM 1294) From I-27, take Exit 11 (Shallowater Exit), turn east and go about ½ mile, we are the first building on the right (south side of road).
<b>Registration:</b>	Opens March 1 <sup>st</sup> on 4-H Connect. <b>All registrants must be enrolled as 4-H members or adult volunteers on 4-H Connect. Adults must have a current Youth Protection background check.</b> Cost is \$120/registrant which includes lunch and dinner on Saturday and the 4-H Curriculum.
<b>4-H Connect Dates:</b>	Opens: March 1, 2019 Closes: March 31, 2019
<b>Training:</b>	The training will include classroom education and live firing exercises covering shooting and coaching principles, curriculum training, 4-H basics, and more.
<b>Certifications:</b>	Certified 4-H Coach – must be a minimum of 21 years of age Assistant 4-H Coach – 14 to 20 years of age
