**DIVISIONS:** In the invitational contest, there will be 3 divisions with awards for each division:

- Junior Grades 3, 4 & 5 (and 8 years old as of 8/31/2021)
- Intermediate Grades 6, 7 & 8 (juniors can compete as intermediates, but they will participate in ALL the intermediate activities)
- Senior Grades 9, 10, 11 & 12
