8:40 a.m. or sooner each day, In Front of THE CLUB HOUSE
CONTEST BEGINS: Competition begins after Orientation. Please be on time.
REGISTER in 2 PLACES **FIRST:** Register on **4-H ONLINE** for the Pete Peterson Invitational
SECOND: Register on **ICLAYS**. **Registrations submitted on IClays that do NOT have a corresponding 4-H Online registration are VOID and will be deleted.**

Your 4-H Shooting Sports members are cordially invited to the 2022 South Plains District 2 Trap and Skeet Shoot. This activity will be held on June 24 & 25, 2022. Our aim is to offer you and your shooters a quality shoot with an exceptional awards program. This shoot could serve as a good warm-up just prior to State and assist in preparing your shooters for really stiff competition in the near future. Opening ceremonies will be conducted by Shooting Sports Ambassadors.

Please note the following:

- **HOA will be Trap, Skeet, Whiz-Bang & Sporting Clays**
- Sr. 2 High Shooter that is a graduating senior from District 2 in **Trap** will receive a scholarship.
Sr. 2 High Shooter that is a graduating senior from DISTRICT 2 in **Skeet** will receive a scholarship.
Sr. 2 High Shooter that is a graduating senior from DISTRICT 2 **shooting both 5-Stand and Sporting Clays** will receive a scholarship.

To be eligible proof of college enrollment or military enrollment must be completed by **October 1, 2022.**

- **2022 Registration fee for Trap, Skeet, Whiz-Bang and Sporting Clay is \$25 per event. Round fees are \$5 for Trap and \$5 for Skeet. Round fee for Whiz-Bang is \$15 for a round of 50 targets. Sporting Clay fees are \$30 for the 100 target round for ALL age groups. Bring money to the shoot. Please make payment for the group with one check to South Plains 4-H Shooting Sports.**
- **Management reserves the right to change squads and/or move shooters to open fields as needed.**
- **Trap & Skeet** number of targets: Jr. 50 Int. 75 Sr. 1 & Sr. 2 100. All age groups will shoot 50 targets for **Whiz-Bang.** In **Sporting Clays**, All age groups-100 Targets
- **Deadline for registration on 4H Online and IClays is no later than 11:59 p.m. June 17, 2022.**
- **At LEAST THREE EXPERIENCED VOLUNTEERS PER COUNTY to pull & score. WE NEED VOLUNTEERS !!!!**
- Eye and ear protection required.
- **Trap** on Friday, **June 24; Skeet, Whiz Bang and Sporting Clays** on Saturday, **June 25.**
- Competitors' will be squadded in order in which registration on **ICLAYS** are received.
- No protest will be acknowledged without a **\$100 protest fee** and no discussions about a protest will be held on the range in front of the public. **Period. No Discussion!**
- We will place 6 deep in each division.
- **AR style, home defense style shotguns, or pistol grip style shotguns are NOT ALLOWED.**
- Conventional shotguns must have a barrel length at least 24 inches and a conventional stock.
- Bring your own ammunition (7 1/2 or smaller shot). Bring your own shade. No ammunition for sale.
- Concession Stand will be available at both locations.
- 4-H Shooting Sports Dress Code followed including, Sleeved Shirts, Closed toe shoes, No open toe shoes. No Crocs. No Sleeveless shirts etc.
- **No practice or walk thru after sporting clays range is set.**
- **Mandatory orientation at 8:40 a.m. or sooner each day**
Competition will begin after orientation. **PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE EARLY.**

Trap will be held at the Palmer Gun Club in Garza County, located 10 miles west of Post on Hwy 380 (&- or) 16 miles east of Tahoka on North side of the road.

Skeet, Whiz-Bang and Sporting Clays will be held at the Gaines County Shooting Range, 7 miles North of Seminole or 8 miles South of Seagraves on Hwy 62/385; then 1 mile West on CR 216, then .6 miles Northwest on CR 216A.
