Only archers who have been coached by 4-H trained and certified coaches may compete.

AGE Divisions- Based on 2022-2023 4-H year age divisions effective as of 09/01/22.

- **3rd Grade Junior** (and minimum age of 8)
- **Junior** – Grades 4 & 5
- **Intermediate** – Grades 6, 7 & 8
- **Senior** – Grades 9, 10, 11 & 12

Equipment Classes:

- **Bare Bow** (longbow or recurve) – Bows may not be equipped with sights or sighting marks. Mechanical release aids are not permitted.
- **Recurve Aided** – Bows may be equipped with a single sighting device, single pin, multiple pin, or hunting style sights. May not be equipped with string peeps or string marks for rear sights. Mechanical release aids are not permitted.
- **Compound Aided** – Bows may be equipped with magnified sights. Mechanical release aids are permitted.
- **Compound Unaided** – (compound, universal or NASP/Genesis bows) Bows may not be equipped with sights, releases, or stabilizers. Any style of arrow rest will be allowed. Mechanical release aids are not permitted.
- **Arrows** – No broad head tip arrows will be allowed.
- * Each shooter can enter a maximum of 2 equipment classes.

Courses of Fire:

Targets:

- **Paper Targets** (20)
- **Novelty Shots** (4)

* **Once Shooter is in the Shooting Ring or Firing Course** - No Coaching will be allowed. Participants will not be allowed to walk up to the target prior to shooting.

Scoring:

Shooters will work together to score targets. Coaches will be available to answer questions. Arrows are scored as they lie in the target or by the identifiable hole if they passed through or bounced out. If there is disagreement or any question on a score, it is resolved on scoring sheets and/or by calling a range official before any arrow is pulled. All scoring sheets must agree and be fully filled out.

Tie Breakers:

- 1st - 10X, 10s, 9s etc.

Dress Requirement:

- Close-toed shoes **are required** unless for a medical reason. No Crocs.
- All other 4-H Shooting Sports Dress Code rules apply (sleeved shirts, close-toed shoes, etc.)

- ✿ Safe and respectful behavior is expected of Shooters, Coaches and spectators at all times. Disorderly, unsafe, or abusive conduct has no place on the Shooting Sports Range and will not be permitted! Any problems can & may lead to disqualification.
- ✿ All certified coaches are encouraged to help with the contest if possible.
- ✿ Shooting will begin immediately following orientation. If you're not at orientation, you won't be allowed to shoot.
