REGISTRATION: 4-H Online will open for registration on April 3rd at 7:00 a.m. 4-H Online will close on April 18, or when 180 have registered – whichever occurs first. Registration fee (\$250) may either be paid by credit card or county check (discuss with your agent on this option). **No refunds will be made after April 18th**

Preparing for Lab

We understand that Leader Lab may be the first away-from-home experience for some of our 4-H members. Parents should have a conversation with the youth about what to expect at camp.

Youth will be actively participating in events from early morning to very late into the evening. If you are not comfortable with your child staying up past 11 pm, Leader Lab may not be the best choice for him/her.

Packing for Lab

Tennis Shoes,

Cell phones- Ceta Canyon has no cell phone service. Please do not send a phone with your child.

Swimsuits: Ceta Canyon recommends one piece swimsuits for the girls; however modest tankinis are also permitted. Bikinis may be worn with a tank top or t-shirt worn over the swimsuit. For guys, we do not allow speedos. Modest swim trunks (no short shorts) are best. T-shirts do not have to be worn, but some boys choose to wear them for modesty.

We will not be responsible for any item your child brings to camp. Please consider what you allow your kid to bring.

Coming to Lab

ARRIVAL: Check-in will be Wednesday, June 1 from 10:15- 11:30 at Ceta Canyon (specific place will be designated later). At check-in, campers will receive their rooming assignment. They are not allowed to change rooms. The camp opening ceremony will begin at 11:45 a.m.

Please arrive with:

- 1) Code of Conduct
- 2) Medical Authorization Form/Assumption of Risk
- 3) Medical Information Form
- 4) Ceta Canyon Medical History, Agreement to Participate, Assumption of Risk and Release of Liability Form (this is all one form) and
- 5) ANY MEDICATIONS. (There is a new form coming out soon from Texas 4-H. This will be located on our District 2 4-H website)

Time at Lab

- ALL campers will have the opportunity to participate in ALL sessions! Activities include: waterslides, swimming, low ropes, outdoor learning center, fishing, hiking, ziplining, big swing, jumping pillow, basketball, sand volleyball, gaga ball and several sessions taught by our counselors. - Please have a discussion with your child about “checking their cool at the door.” The more involved they are in activities, the more they will take away from lab.
- Youth will be actively participating in events from early morning to very late into the evening.
- All campers are expected to observe the designated curfew and ‘lights out’ times.

Supervision at Lab

Background checks and CPT training are current on all employees. Agents will go through an orientation upon arrival and have been given a chaperone position description.

Campers will be placed in color groups that are directed by two high school counselors. These counselors are selected through an application process. They are required to attend multiple trainings conducted through Teams prior to lab. They also arrive one day early to prepare for lab.

Departure from Lab

Lab will finish at 10 a.m. on Friday, May 31st. A County Extension Agent or counselor must check your child’s room before departure.
