GRADE REQUIREMENTS - Based on 2024-2025 4-H year age requirements effective as of 09/01/24.

- Junior Grades 3, 4 & 5
- Intermediate Grades 6, 7 & 8
- Senior Grades 9, 10, 11 & 12
- <u>Senior teams MUST have four members.</u> Junior and Intermediate teams may have 3-4 members but MUST have at least 3 members to compete.
- Juniors can compete on intermediate teams, but no other moving can occur (intermediates cannot compete as juniors and no age group can move up to the senior division).
- Counties may enter as many Junior, Intermediate and Senior teams as needed.
