I. AGE REQUIREMENTS – based on 2024-2025 4-H year effective as of 09/01/2024

Junior – 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade

■ Intermediate – 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade

Senior – 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

It is the responsibility of the agents to make sure that 4 -H members are entered in the correct age category. Counties may move juniors up to intermediates, but intermediates cannot be moved up to seniors or down to juniors.

### II. Contest Format

- This contest will be using scantron form Universal A. These will be provided to all participants on the day of the contest.
- Contestants need to bring a #2 pencil and a clipboard.
- Seniors will be required to give three sets of reasons. Intermediates will be required to give one set of reasons which will be calculated in their overall score.

horse pleasure and ranch riding.
