Contest

Contest Categories: Wearable, Non-Wearable and Accessory/Jewelry

<u>Members per team</u>: Each team will have at least three (3) and no more than four (4) members. <u>Sewing kit</u>: Each team must supply their own equipment for the competition. A team can choose not to include a listed item, but no additional items can be added.

District 2 Important Reminders:

- Each county may enter as many Junior, Intermediate or Senior teams as they would like.
- Juniors can compete with an Intermediate team in the Intermediate Age Level.
- Juniors and Intermediates may not be combined with a Senior Team.
- All age divisions will follow the competition rules outlined in The Texas 4-H Duds to Dazzle Contest Guide. The guide and other contest resources are listed below.
- AGENT BOX CHECK Agents, please check your county's boxes prior to the contest.
 There will be NO items added to boxes at the contest. In addition, the committee will NOT have extra items for teams to use.
- <u>Cost/value of item</u>: Juniors and Intermediates will be given a cost/value of the original items. Senior teams will NOT receive this information.
- **Box labeling:** Each team's box needs to be labeled with county, age division, team number (if applicable), and team member's names (just like Food Challenge).

• Results will be posted on the District 2 4-H Facebook page. The top 3 in each category will be announced at the Fashion show awards that afternoon. You do not have to stay and be present for the awards, awards will be sent with agents if needed.

Texas 4-H Roundup Advancement

• Each district may advance three senior teams to compete in the state contest. Teams advancing to state will not automatically be assigned to the same category as they were at district. District 2 will send the 1st place team in each category.

Agent Assignments and Responsibilities

- Agent assignments will be determined for each contest at the committee workday.
- All FCH and 4-H Extension Agents should be prepared to attend and assist with the contest. Agent and volunteer assignments will be emailed following the committee workday.
