AGE REQUIREMENTS - Age is based on 2024-2025 4-H year age requirements effective as of 09/01/24.

- Junior Grades 3, 4, & 5 (and minimum age of 8)
- Intermediate Grades 6, 7, & 8
- Senior Grades 9, 10, 11, & 12

Counties may enter as many teams as they wish. Counties may move Juniors up to Intermediates, but Intermediates will NOT be allowed to move down to Juniors.

CONTEST FORMAT - Contestants will judge four soil profiles with 20 minutes allowed for each. They will then determine the soil characteristics of the profiles and make interpretations based on observation. Entry in district is not required to advance to state.
